BOGG Grant

This grant is a fee waiver(exempt from paying) for California Community College classes. Not to be confused with the California College Promise Grant (CCPG)

Bureau of Indian Affairs

This bureau provides assistance to Native American and Alaskan tribes.

This program provides cash aid and services to eligible families that have children at home.

CalWORKS-Referral

Job preparation services provided by Greater Avenue for Independence (GAIN).
CalWORKS-SIP

This program is for individuals who are already in school before applying for cash aid through the CalWorks program.



Assistance Received: Select <u>ALL</u> that Apply

This program provides cash assistance to older immigrants and immigrants with disabilities.

Food Stamps

This program is for eligible individuals and provides cash assistance for groceries.

GA (General Assistance) or GR (General Relief)

This program provides support for adults that can't support themselves and are not receiving public assistance, except for CalFresh.

GI Bill (Veterans Only)

This program provides assistance to service members, veterans, and their dependents.

Medi-Cal

This program provides free or low-cost medical services for children and adults with limited income and resources.



Assistance Received: Select <u>ALL</u> that Apply

You are a worker or a dependent who are unable to return to your residence within the same day.

Pell Grant

This program provides financial assistance to low income individuals to go to college.

Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

This program provides monthly cash assistance for basic needs to older adults and individuals with disabilities.

This program provides food and nutritional assistance to eligible children under 5, pregnant women, and eligible single parents with children up to age 5.

This program helps people looking for jobs to access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market.




